PREPARE FOR HUNTING SEASON



HABITAT TIPS-SEPTEMBER

- Prepare ground and plant winter food plots
- Conduct soil tests on food plot sites
- Millet or goat weed make good dove feed
- Shred around tanks to facilitate dove coming to water
- Monitor range conditions and evaluate livestock densities going into fall and winter
- Implement the use of trails cameras to aid in population observation before harvest season

Simple reminders:

- Take your **hunters education course**. Hunters born on or after Sept. 2, 1971 are required to complete this course. Youth can attend at 9 years old.
- Purchase a license. Sales opened August 15 for hunting and fishing licenses, including the new Super Combo which will authorize digital tagging of harvested deer, turkey and oversized red drum. The digital license is available through online purchase only. This license will need to be available while in the field and can be accessed through the TPWD Outdoor Annual and My Texas Hunt Harvest mobile apps.
- Know the rules and regulations as some changes have been made. See the Outdoor Annual for official rules.

NEW MESQUITE CONTOL DEMO

Testing and comparing the efficacy of Sendero and Sendero mixes



This mesquite site is a broadcast application with Corteva AgriScience using Sendero, Sendero plus Remedy Ultra at three different rates, and Sendero with a test chemical.

We are excited to share preliminary results on the two new brush demonstration plots conducted with AgriLife Range specialist Dr. Megan Clayton.



Brush was sprayed at late in the season, after significant drought conditions but received about 6 inches of rain within two weeks after application. This test plot will be monitored for two years.

NEW MIXED BRUSH FENCELINECONTOL DEMO

Testing and comparing the efficacy of Invora and Invora mixes





The fenceline applied research project is in conjunction with Bayer CropSciences. We are looking at Individual Plant Treatment applications on a variety of mixed brush with Invora and 5 Invora mixes compared to Surmount at 2% (7 treatments total).

We sprayed during the drought, although plants were in good condition, but soil moisture measured zero, and soil temperature measured high.
